

Purpose

The Campus Emergency Management Plan addresses compatibility with the California State University (CSU) system as well as with the state of California Emergency City President or designee whenever an emergency affecting the campus is anticipated capacity of routine procedures, and de-President or designee when all phases of managing the emergency have concluded.

The Emergency Management Plan for Humboldt State University outlines the actions to be taken by the University in response to emergency situations. The probability of an emergency cannot be eliminated, but proper preparation and an awareness of the potential for emergencies should enable the University to anticipate, identify and correct hazardous conditions which could otherwise contribute to the occurrence of an emergency. Prior planning will allow the University to respond in a coordinated and effective manner and minimize the impacts of the emergency.

The primary goals of emergency management are the preservation of life, the protection of property, and continuity of campus operations. The purpose and design of the Emergency Management Plan are to:

- ◆ Prescribe authority and responsibility of functions and operations of the campus Emergency Management resources.
- ◆ operations through mutual aid and other support
